



"The Department will provide a safe transportation system that ensures the mobility of people and goods, enhances economic prosperity and preserves the quality of our environment and communities."



Overland Bridge Project


Began: January 2012

Work: Replaces I-95 Overland Bridges








I-95 and JTB (Butler Boulevard)

Cost: \$67 million

> Finish: mid-2017

Work: Rebuild interchange; safety improvements; drainage improvements; add sidewalks; redesigned merges; flyover

Begin: October 2014

Cost: \$89 million

Finish: Late 2017

Type of Work: Add express lanes with electronic

tolling; reconstruct

I-295 E Express Lanes JTB to 9B

- > Begin: June 2016
- Cost: \$140 million
- > Finish: Spring 2019
- Type of Work: Add express lanes; electronic toll lanes; reconstruct



I-295 Express Lanes (9B to JTB)

Begin: June 2016

Cost: \$140 million

Finish: Late 2018

Work: Add express lanes and improve current interchanges



Dames Point Bridge Rehabilitation

Begin: August 2016

Cost: \$4.5 million

> Finish: Summer 2017

Work: repair of fender system, joints and shear lock mechanisms; minor resurfacing; most of work below bridge but requires daytime lane closures 8am-6pm

Cost: \$76.9 million

> Finish: Mid-2017



Begin: May 2014

Cost: \$84.9 million

> Finish: Mid-2017

Type of Work: New electronic toll road in addition to existing non-toll service roads; new interchanges



First Coast Expressway Argyle Forest Blvd to Blanding Blvd





Blanding Boulevard Old Jennings Rd. to just south of Baxley Rd.

> Begin: August 2015

Cost: \$16 Million

Finish: Spring 2017

Type of Work: Reconstruct, widen to six lanes; add bike lanes and sidewalk in both directions; replace signals; add street lights; new drainage system

I-10 to Beaver Street (U.S. 90)

> Begin: July 2015

Cost: \$45.8 million

> Finish: Summer 2018

Type of Work: major reconstruction at I-10 resulting in a partial clover-leaf type interchange; 3 of 4 ramps to be loop ramps; ramps being constructed at Beaver St. for access to/from I-10 and First Coast Expressway.



Cost: \$10.4 Million


> Finish: Fall 2018

Work: Add lanes; extend I-295 ramps N of Commonwealth; drainage; resurface; widen railroad overpass; upgrade lighting, signs, guardrails

Hart Bridge Repair and Rehab

> Begin: September 2016


Cost: \$4.3 Million

> Finish: Fall 2017

Work: Replace wire rope, coat steel, drainage, general repair


Emerson St. Resurface from Spring Park to Hart System

Begin: September 2016

Cost: \$1.7 Million

Finish: Spring 2017

Work: Resurface; upgrade pedestrian signals; sidewalk repair; JEA replacing water main

- Finish: Spring 2019
- Work: Interchange reconstruction; operational improvements

Baldwin Bypass

Begin: Febuary 2017

Cost: \$60 million

Finish: late 2019

Type of Work: new 4-mile, 4-lane divided highway north I-10 westbound on-ramp; 2 new signalized intersections at Beaver St. and Brandy Branch Rd; plans include overpass across two CSX railroad crossings; overpass over Jacksonville-Baldwin Rail Trail






I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements

Begin: Summer 2017

Cost: \$126 million

> Finish: Summer 2020

Type of Work: Operational improvements; add lane for exit to Fuller Warren Bridge from I-10; new flyover to Stockton; improve Roosevelt merge with I-10; pedestrian/bike trail south side of Fuller Warren connecting Riverside and San Marco


I-95 Typical Section (Duval County)



Begin: January 2017

Cost: \$34 million

Finish: Late 2019

Type of Work: I-95 to west of Still Quarters Rd widening; interchange reconstruction with diverging diamond
